1. Presentation by the various associations on the harm caused by the planned biogas plant near Camposol and the poor choice of location.

2. Explanation by the Councillor of the current situation of the project

- The project for the installation of the biogas plant in Mazarrón has had a favourable report from the Town Planning Technician since October 2024, in accordance with the 1990 General Urban Development Plan.
- The Environmental Impact Statement for the project depends exclusively on the Regional Ministry of the Environment of the Region of Murcia.
- It requires the approval of the building permit, which must be submitted to the Mazarrón Town Council for approval.

3. AGREEMENTS

- The PSOE group in the Town Council is going to prepare a motion to modify the General Urban Development Plan, prohibiting industrial facilities of this type within 5,000 m of urban centres.
- The Councillor for Town Planning has undertaken not to sign the building permit, but the mayor can sign it unilaterally by decree.

The Associations have committed to:

- **Working together to halt the project, joining forces with other neighbourhood associations in Mazarrón, Puerto de Mazarrón, Bahía, etc.**
- Disseminating the information among all the residents in our area and gathering as many objections as possible. Organising public events.
- Meet in 15 days to prepare for the meeting already requested with the mayor and request a meeting with the Regional Minister for the Environment of the CARM
