One Year Report

The association has been in existence for nearly a year and has been quietly going about its business with the objectives set out at its inception. Amongst the work we have been doing, in no particular order is:

- 1) Harnessing the objections and registering allegations to stop the proposed Biogas plant just over 1km away from Camposol. We are also liaising with other associations that are affected by this proposed development. This work is ongoing and the outcome will affect us all for many years to come. - 2) Developing a series of proposals to deal with the green waste issues on Camposol. We set out a series of proposals including, clearing the waste on all sectors, opening a temporary collection point, creating an posting signage with clear instructions as to where green waste may be left, and pointing out the consequences of non compliance and installing cameras to attempt to dissuade or catch perpetrators. Again, this is ongoing as not all of the agreed activities have been carried out.
- 3) Assisting the town hall in issuing the notifications for the change in planning status of Camposol. We may have met some of you during this process in recent months at the Camposol Social Centre.
- 4) Providing support and assistance to neighbours in dealing with bureaucratic issues within the Spanish system. This has included helping people with accessing social services, benefits and utility discounts during our sessions at the social centre from 10 am till 1pm on Wednesdays and Fridays recommencing on 1st September.

AVC is a neighbourhood association and is not to be confused with the now defunct Camposol Residents Association, as our approach is one of cooperating with the town hall while holding them to account where they fall short in the provision of services and/or not fulfilling agreements that have been made for the betterment of Camposol.
