



The green waste depot in Sector C, which the City Council promised to manage and maintain, is in deplorable condition. All agreements reached between the council and AVC regarding green waste, have been systematically undone and breached. The depot has been open 24 hours a day throughout the summer without any surveillance or oversight, nor any informational signage about opening hours, regulations, or internal parceling for sorting waste. Now the Councilor for Services has unilaterally decided to put a lock on it without telling anyone or announcing new opening hours.

These photos are from this morning at 11:15, when, according to the information sign in the parking lot in Sector B, the waste depot was supposed to be open. The residents of Camposol are fed up with the broken promises, the widespread neglect of our town, the dirty streets, living at constant risk of fires because the firebreaks required by law have not been built, ... and now the Biogas Plant.



We wonder what the mayor's plan is for Camposol, It is now four weeks since AVC made an official request for a meeting with the him, followed up with a second request two weeks later. No response has been received yet, which is strange as in the past four weeks there have been many publicity photos of the mayor meeting with other groups and associations. Many of us are starting to wonder why we have to pay property taxes to a city council that clearly discriminates against us fails to fulfil agreements it has made. Neighbors, perhaps it's time to stop talking and take other measures that are proportional to the seriousness of the situation.

AVC is in contact with the town hall to seek a resolution to this situation. In the meantime we request that neighbors do not resort to dumping green waste in other areas of Camposol, especially the former green waste areas.
